Danish System of Judging

Although the exhibits need not be owned by the exhibitor, all must be the product of students as a regular part of their instruction in Ag Mechanics for the past year. The student exhibitor must have been at least the major contributor to the building & repairing of the exhibit. No entry may be shown for more than one calendar year. An article may not be entered in more than one *class* & each exhibitor may not enter more than one article from the same pattern.

Display cards must be filled out & attached to each exhibit in this department, correctly labeling the exhibit & giving a brief summary of the students project.

No Entry Fee—Local Divisions

Entries in the following divisions must have been made, collected, grown or prepared & entered by exhibitors who were enrolled in these projects in 4-H Youth programs within one year of the opening date of the Fair, except as otherwise noted. If an exhibitor is in the 4H Program but NOT ENROLLED in a specific project, they may enter in the Open Junior Department. Example: If a member is enrolled in 4H Foods but is not enrolled in 4H Arts & Crafts, the member can enter Open Junior Arts & Crafts, but must enter 4H Foods. NO—CROSS entries are allowed.

BEGINNING: 1st & 2nd Year

INTERMEDIATE: 3rd & 4th Year

ADVANCED: 5th Year & Above

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4-H EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS

An Educational Exhibit may consist of visual information regarding 4-H Projects, i.e., production, labor costs, etc. 1 entry per exhibitor.
