Specimen bloom stem length to be proportional to the bloom, no leaf needed. Dahlias to be disbudded.

ROSES

Outdoor grown roses shall be exhibited 1/2 to 3/4 open, including thorns & full foliage on stem above the water line. All specimens should be appropriately named, if known. Example: Rose, Red, Hybrid Tea, Mr. Lincoln
