Entry Fee: \$4 per entry per class
Entry Limit: 3 entries per exhibitor per class

RULES:

- ❖ All rabbits must be identified by a permanent ear tattoo matching that on the entry form.
- ❖ A numbered leg band must identify all poultry. The leg band number must match that on the entry form.
- ❖ Poultry inspection will be performed prior to coup-in from 3–5pm July 14, 2009.
- ❖ This is an Open Table Show. Open Youth & Adult will be judged together.
- ❖ All small animals will be housed on grounds for the duration of the fair, their release date will be Sunday, July 19 at 5pm.
- ❖ All entered as specific breeds will be judged by the rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association & American Poultry Standard or Perfection.
- ❖ No carriers will be available to bring the animals to the tables. Exhibitors are expected to be on hand during judging to bring their animals to the judging tables.
- ❖ Junior Rabbits & Poultry must be checked in by a junior exhibitor, or entry will not be accepted.
