

RABBITS

All rabbits must be identified by a permanent ear tattoo matching that on the entry form. Exhibitors must have carry cages for their entries. Cages are limited, be prepared to provide your own. Cages must have solid bottoms and be leak proof. No carriers will be available to bring the animals to the judging tables. Exhibitors are expected to be on hand during judging to bring their animals to the judging tables. Exhibit will not be judged if exhibitor misses his or her call to bring rabbits to the table. Only youth exhibitors may carry animals to the judging table. All small animals will be housed on grounds for the duration of the Fair, their release date will be Sunday of fair week at 4PM. Junior rabbits must be checked in by a junior exhibitor, or entry will not be accepted.

American System of judging.

No cash awards. Ribbons only.

Pen of 3. Weight 3.5lbs minimum, 5.5lbs maximum each rabbit. Seventy-day age limit. All entries must have a permanent ear tattoo. There is no average daily gain requirement. All qualified meat pens will sell through the Junior Livestock Auction. All small market animals is live pickup. All rabbit market pens will be required to present a bill of sale at check-in. Pens not having a bill of sale will not be allowed to sell. If you choose to breed and raise your own market animals, you must still have a breeding statement/bill of sale. Grade groups: Purple and Red = market ready, White = not market ready (will not sell).

DIVISION 150– 4-H RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP

Class:

1. **4-H True Novice Showmanship**—Open to any 4-H member who has never shown before at any organized Show/Fair regardless of grade level. Winner of 4-H True Novice Showmanship is not eligible to move up to the next class for the final round.

2. **4-H Junior Showmanship**—Open to only 9, 10 & 11 years olds as of January 1st of show year regardless of number of years in 4-H. Top 3 advance to Advanced Showmanship

3. **4-H Intermediate Showmanship**—Open to only 12 & 13 years old as of January 1st of show year regardless of number of years in 4-H. Top 3 advance to Advanced Showmanship

4. **4-H Advanced**—14 years & over as of January 1st of show year.

DIVISION 151– FFA RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP

Class:

1. **FFA True Novice Showmanship**—Open to any FFA member who has never shown before at any organized show/Fair regardless of grade level. Winner of FFA True Novice Showmanship is not eligible to move up to the next class for the final round

2. **FFA Junior Showmanship**—Open to 10th grade and under, top 2 to advance to FFA Advanced Showmanship round.

3. **FFA Advanced Showmanship**—Open to 11th grade and over.
