- 1. Ranch Box N Box (Cattle Class) Youth will only do boxing at one end of the arena then finish (time 50 seconds). Select & Adult will work cow one end of arena, bring cow to other end work the cow and then ask for gate to let cow out (time 1 min 45 seconds)
- **2. Ranch Pleasure** Each age division will enter the arena together and perform a rail class being given instructions by the judge.
- **3. Ranch Riding** The rider will perform a pre-learned pattern on their own in front of the judge in the arena.
- **4. Ranch Reining** The rider will perform a pre-learned pattern on their own in front of the judge in the arena.
- **5. Ranch Trail** The trail course will be open throughout the day for each rider to complete in their own time the course will be open for a walk through at the start of the day.
- **6. Halter** The handler will lead their horse into the arena, meet the judge then perform a maneuver given by the judge and stay lined up in the arena.
