DIVISION 164-4-H SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

Class:

1. **4-H True Novice Showmanship**—Open to any 4-H member who has never shown before at any organized Show/Fair regardless of grade level. Winner of 4-H True Novice Showmanship is not eligible to move up to the next class for the final round.

2. **4-H Junior Showmanship**—Open to only 9, 10 & 11 years olds as of January 1st of show year regardless of number of years in 4-H.

Top 3 advance to Advanced Showmanship

3. **4-H Intermediate Showmanship**—Open to only 12 & 13 years old as of January 1st of show year regardless of number of years in 4-H.

Top 3 advance to Advanced Showmanship

4. **4-H Advanced**—14 years & over as of January 1st of show year.

DIVISION – 165 FFA SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

Class:

1. **FFA True Novice Showmanship**—Open to any FFA member who has never shown before at any organized show/Fair regardless of grade level. Winner of FFA True Novice Showmanship is not eligible to move up to the next class for the final round
